

“The Supreme Splendor of the Son of Man” Revelation Part 2
Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14; Revelation 1:9-20

“Your companion in the suffering and kingdom ...” (v. 9). The only way from affliction to glory: Patient Endurance found in Christ Alone.

“Seven golden lampstands” (v. 12). Seven Churches. Jesus stands in the midst of his people identifying with our Mission and Struggles.

“His robe reaching down to his feet” (v. 13). The High Priest (Heb. 4). The One who Intercedes for us.

“His hair white like wool, white as snow” (v. 14). Absolute, incorruptible Wisdom and Worthiness (see Daniel 7:9, 13-14).

“His eyes like a blazing fire” (v. 14). Clear vision and true judgement. He comes to his people Powerfully, Personally & Purposefully.

“His feet like bronze glowing in a furnace” (v. 15). His strength. The Son of Man Sustains, Strengthens & Delivers his witnesses.

“His voice like the sound of rushing waters” (v. 15). Unending authority stretching over All of Creation (see Ezekiel 1:4, 24).

“In his right hand he held seven stars” (v. 16). Angels of the 7 churches. He Commands his angels and does so on behalf of his Churches.

“Coming out of his mouth was a double-edged sword” (v. 16). Executes perfect justice (Isaiah 11). Proclaims the word, for he is the Word.

“His face like the sun shining in all its brilliance” (v. 16). (see Matt. 17, John 1:9-14). The Profound and the Personal.

“Don’t be afraid ... I am the Living One!” The same Lord who stands in the midst of his churches, who holds the angels in his hands, Comes to us, Touches us, and Calms Our Fears.

Jesus can do today Everything He Has Ever Done.

Jesus comes to those who Cannot Come to Him.

Jesus possesses Every Ability We Need to accomplish his purposes.

Jesus deserves Our Awe.
