

“The Cure for Compromise” – Revelation Part 6
Revelation 2:18-29 (Letter to Thyatira)

The Call to Compromise

Moral compromise was the greatest temptation in Thyatira.

“You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet. By her teaching, she misleads my servants ... ” (v. 20)

“Jezebel” is the voice of compromise.

The Call to Courage

“These are the words of the Son of God” (v. 18)

“I will make those who commit adultery with her suffer intensely, unless they repent of their ways” (v. 22)

“All the churches will know that I am he who searches hearts and minds, and I will repay each of you according to your deeds” (v. 23)

“To you who do not hold to her teaching and have not learned Satan’s so-called deep secrets” (v. 24)

“I will not impose any other burden on you, except to hold on to what you have until I come.” (v. 25)

“To the one who is victorious and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations” (v. 26)

“I will also give that one the morning star.” (v. 28)

In summary – Jesus repays every sacrifice our courage requires.

Where will you turn? To the compromise of our culture or to courage for the Kingdom?
